

## “Thailand Cyber Crimes Update: Big Brother is Watching You”

On 19 July 2007 Thailand's new Computer Crimes Act (CCA) came into effect. Section 26 of the CCA makes data retention mandatory for all “Service Providers”, who are now required to keep records of their users email, chat history, and internet usage and personal identification for a minimum of 90 days. The Ministry of Information and Communication Technology is taking a broad interpretation of the new law stating that all entities offering internet access, computer communication or data storage to their staff will fall within the CCA data retention requirements.

Now nearly any party who uses a computer is required to log all data traffic and maintain personal data to identify users for 90 days or be subject to a criminal fine of up to 500,000 Baht. Are you a Service Provider and subject to these requirements?
