

Exposure of Directors: Traditional Risks and Some Surprises

The scope of potential civil and criminal liability for directors (and officers) of Thai companies is often broader than normally perceived, and growing. The administrative responsibilities of companies are generally well known. But less commonly realized are general requirements under the Alien Business Law, legislation relating to fiscal matters and for foreigners under labor and immigration law. And liabilities for activities in specific areas, such as industry, environment and labor, health and safety, are often not well recognized.

This presentation will consider the exposure in these sectors and activities, whether due to negligent acts or omissions or strict liability, will cover current enforcement trends and will suggest measures to mitigate such risks.
