Corporate Members are juristic (corporate) entities with substantial links with Norway registered in Myanmar or branches of juristic entities registered abroad, which the Board considers will contribute to the achievement of its objectives. Corporate members can also be intending investors in Myanmar or juristic entities registered in Norway with broad business dealings with Myanmar and who seek to keep informed of council activities and business developments in Myanmar.

INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP

Individual members are natural persons acceptable to the chamber, but who lack the qualifications for corporate membership.

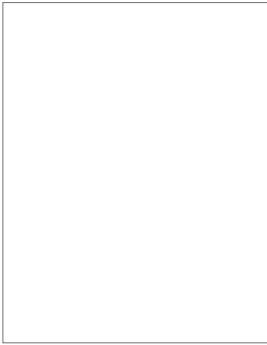

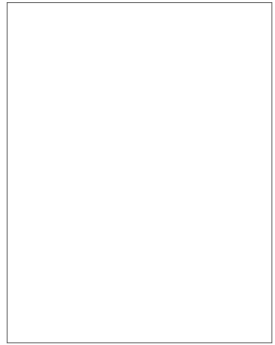
